Life Sketch of Dr. Md. Afsarul Ameen Minister for Primary and Mass Education.

Dr. Md. Afsarul Ameen was born on 1st January 1952 in a noted muslim family of Chittagong district. His father late Dr. Md. Fazlul Ameen was a eminent doctor, prominent educationist and social reformer.

Dr. Ameen obtained MBBS degree from Chittagong Medical College in 1979.

He got involved into political sphere of Bangladesh Chattra League inspired by the ideology of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, During his student life. He served as general secretary of Bangladesh Chattra League of Chittagong Medical College unit. He elected as relief and social walfare secretary of City Awami League, Chittagong in 1992 and also elected as organizing secretary of the same party in 1997. He elected as joint secretary general of Chittagong City Awami League in 2006.

He kept contribution in the independence of Bangladesh through active participation in the war of Liberation in 1971.

Dr. Ameen was elected as a member of 9th parliament from the constituency of 286 representing Chittagong-9 held on 29th December 2008 in general election and sworn in on 6th January 2009 as Minister, Ministry of Shipping.

In July 31, 2009 he took charge of Minister, Ministry of Primary and Mass Education .

Dr Ameen has an active participation in different types of social activities is know as a clean man in politics. He was praised for his activities at the time of post cyclone period by establishing field hospitals to ensure instant treatment of wounded people when most of the area of Chittagong was badly effected by the Cyclone in 1991.

Dr. Ameen is married. He is blessed with two sons. His wife Dr. Kamrunnessa is also a reputed Doctor and a philanthropist.
